As the institution is situated in rural area most of the students came from uneducated, economically poor and socially disadvantaged families. The standby power supply facility such as UPS (Uninterrupted Power Supply), invertor set is also available.

In short we have made available whatever we fill necessary for the maximum usage of ICT. But internally, the greatest challenge before the institution is to change the mental setup of our students and employees. However, by continuously motivating them, most of the students and members of teaching and non-teaching staff are taking advantage of the ICT facilities.

#### 2. The Practice: -

We have organized awareness program me to develop the ICT aptitude among the students, teachers and non-teaching employees of the institution. #### **Introduction:**
